Support for Identified Schools

Please describe how the LEA has or will support its eligible schools in developing CSI plans.
Identified Educational Services team members were assigned to support the development and revisions of the 2020-21 School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) to include embedded CSI strategies/activities. The Educational Services team members convened meetings with site leadership to determine the potential causes of the poor student performance on dashboard indicators. Additionally, the team facilitated a deep data dive that identified student groups needing the most support. The Educational Services staff representatives facilitated a number planning sessions with site administrators to involve stakeholders in the needs assessment and planning process. Additionally, school administrators and staff members were supported by Educational Services departments to align actions with WASC recommendations, including the development of alternative courses in English Language Arts and History-Social Sciences to improve student engagement and achievement. The Educational Services team representatives also facilitated a review of district and school site budgeting practices with site administrators to reveal any inequities and support them in the best use of targeted funds to improve outcomes for marginalized students.

Monitoring and Evaluating Effectiveness

Identified Educational Services staff members are assigned to support the CSI identified school. Bi-monthly meetings are scheduled to review progress, make adjustments based on student data and monitor implementation of the planned strategies and activities. Educational Services staff members provide ongoing updates on the status of the implementation of the CSI plan at Director level meetings as well as with the Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services. The assigned Educational Services team members act as thought partners, identify any barriers, devise solutions in collaboration with site administrators, and ensure implementation of the CSI identified strategies and activities.
