Policy 0000

Federal and State laws and the California Education Code guide the policies and practices of the Solano County Office of Education (SCOE), and SCOE strives to maintain legal compliance in all areas at all times. In the absence of a specific SCOE policy, direction may be obtained through laws and state codes, which supersede SCOE policies.

Vision/Mission

Vision Statement: Preparing students to learn, grow, thrive, and achieve lifelong success.

Mission: Promoting equity and excellence by working with our school districts and community partners to create opportunities that address the needs of every student.

In order to provide a clear focus for its programs, activities and operations, the Solano County Office of Education (SCOE) shall adopt a long-range vision that sets direction which is focused on student learning.

The County Superintendent (Superintendent) or designee shall recommend an appropriate process for establishing and/or reviewing SCOE's vision/mission statements.

The Superintendent or designee shall regularly review SCOE's vision/mission statements. Following these reviews, the Superintendent or designee may revise or reaffirm the direction established for SCOE.

The Superintendent or designee shall communicate SCOE's vision/mission to staff, parents/guardians and the community.

The Superintendent or designee shall establish a process for developing and regularly reviewing SCOE's vision and direction.
