Goals

It is the goal of the Solano County Office of Education (SCOE) to respond to the changing needs of the school districts in Solano County with support, collaboration, and leadership.

This means:

- anticipating and proactively identifying the challenges and opportunities of districts, and
- providing support, collaboration, and leadership, considering the full resources available, in order to help districts accomplish their goals.

SCOE will accomplish this in ways that:

- improve the learning outcomes of the students it serves,
- assist in attracting and retaining high quality employees, and
- actively engage in partnerships with relevant government and private organizations.

Goals shall be established for all students as defined in Education Code (EC) 52052, which may include students based on ethnicity, students who are socioeconomically disadvantaged, English learners, students with disabilities, and foster youth, and shall address each of the state priorities identified in EC 52066 and any additional local priorities established by SCOE. These goals shall be incorporated into SCOE's local control and accountability plan (LCAP). (EC 52066, 52068, 52069; as specified in 5 California Code of Regulation (CCR) 15497)

The LCAP shall include a clear description of each goal, one or more of the state or local priorities addressed by the goal, any student subgroup(s) or school/program site(s) to which the goal is applicable, and expected progress toward meeting the goal for the term of the LCAP and in each year. (5 CCR 15479)

Each year SCOE's update to the LCAP shall review progress toward the goals and describe any changes to the goals. (Education Code 52066)

The County Superintendent is committed to realizing SCOE's vision and mission by:

- focusing on prevention and early intervention strategies that address the needs of every student,
- recruiting and retaining high quality employees,
- providing responsive district & school support, and
- advocating for equitable allocation and alignment of resources

SCOE's priorities are included in its Strategic Framework (available as a separate document) developed in collaboration between staff members and community stakeholders represented by parents, teachers, school board members, students, bargain units, business partners, and government leaders. In the strategic planning process, stakeholders identify critical issues that reflect significant challenges or opportunities that must be addressed if student outcomes in Solano County are to improve.
