Policy 0500

Accountability

To ensure the effectiveness of the Solano County Office of Education (SCOE) Juvenile Court and Community Schools (JCCS) programs, services, personnel, and fiscal operations, the County Superintendent or designee shall identify, develop, and regularly review appropriate accountability measures. These measures shall be integrated and consistent with the state's accountability system and may include, but not be limited to, measures to evaluate student achievement, parent/guardian involvement, and other SCOE goals. Systems and processes shall be established to monitor results and evaluate the progress toward accomplishing the SCOE's vision, mission, and goals.

Opportunities for feedback from students, parents/guardians, staff, and community members shall be made available as part of the review and evaluation of SCOE's programs in the context of the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) stakeholder engagement process.

Indicators of progress in improving student achievement shall include, but not be limited to, the Dashboard established by the state's accountability system by school, grade, and student subgroup, including disaggregated data based on socioeconomic status, race/ethnicity, enrollment in special education, English proficiency, and gender.

Following the annual publication of the Dashboard results release by the State Superintendent of Public Instruction, a summary will be presented to the County Board at a regularly scheduled meeting in the context of the ongoing review and development of the LCAP. (Education Code 52056) Evaluation results may be used as a basis for identifying and developing strategies to address disparities in achievement among student subgroups, implementing programmatic changes, and determining the need for additional support or assistance.
