Absence of Policy

Through Solano County Office of Education (SCOE) policy, the County Superintendent tries to anticipate critical policy issues that may affect SCOE's students and operations. However, the Superintendent recognizes that questions may arise in the day-to-day operations of SCOE programs that are not addressed in policy or regulations. When resolution of such issues demands timely action, the Superintendent or designee shall have the authority to act on behalf of SCOE.

Federal, state, and local laws and the California Education Code guide SCOE's policies and practices, and SCOE strives to maintain legal compliance in all areas at all times. In the absence of a specific SCOE policy, direction may be obtained through laws and state codes, which supersede SCOE policies.
