

Representative and Deliberative Groups

The Solano County Office of Education (SCOE) believes that broad input on its operations and policy from staff, parents/guardians, students, school districts, and members of the public can provide SCOE with a diversity of viewpoints and expertise, help build a sense of ownership of the schools, enhance its efficiency and assist its communications. As desired, the County Superintendent or designee may establish a management team, administrative councils, task forces, cabinets, or committees in accordance with law.

The membership, composition and responsibilities of these groups shall be defined by the Superintendent or designee. The Superintendent or designee may establish, change, or dissolve these groups at his/her discretion.

Groups established by the Superintendent or designee shall act in an advisory capacity unless specifically authorized to act on behalf of the Superintendent or designee. Advisory groups shall submit their recommendations to the Superintendent or designee.

Expenses incurred for consulting services, materials, travel, or other related operations shall be approved by the Superintendent or designee in advance.
