Policy 3530

Risk Management/Insurance

The County Superintendent strongly supports a risk management program that protects Solano County Office of Education (SCOE) resources and promotes the safety of students, staff, and the public.

The Superintendent or designee shall establish a risk management program that uses effective safety and loss control practices. SCOE shall strive to keep its liability at a minimum and its insurance premiums as low as possible while maintaining adequate protection. To determine the most economical means of insuring SCOE consistent with required services, the Superintendent or designee shall annually review SCOE's options for obtaining coverage with SCOE's joint powers agency (JPA), North Bay Schools Insurance Authority (NBSIA).

To attempt to minimize SCOE's exposure to liability, SCOE shall adopt clear policies related to discrimination, harassment, safety procedures, and the timely handling of claims. The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that these policies and related procedures are enforced fairly and consistently.

Risk Management

The Superintendent or designee shall take action to:

- 1. Identify the risks inherent in the operation of SCOE programs
- 2. Assess the above risks and keep records of accidents, losses, and damage
- 3. Mitigate risks through loss control and safety-related activities
- 4. Determine the extent to which risks should be assumed by SCOE or covered by the purchase of insurance or pooling with other agencies

Employees are expected to take reasonable precautions for the care and safety of SCOE equipment with which they have been entrusted. Employees may be held responsible for recurring damage or losses that occur due to their negligence or lack of supervision. Responsibilities related to safety and loss control shall be included in employee job descriptions.

Insurance

Insurance coverage shall include, but may not be limited to:

- 1. Liability insurance
- 2. Fire insurance for buildings, equipment, and vehicles
- 3. Workers' compensation insurance
- 4. Fidelity bond insurance

A suitable bond indemnifying SCOE against loss shall be purchased for employees responsible for handling SCOE funds and may be purchased for employees responsible for handling SCOE property. SCOE shall bear the cost of this bonding.
