## **Payment of Wages for Terminating Employees**

Section 202 of the California Labor Code states that terminating employees must receive all wages due not later than 72 hours after an employee quits his/her employment. County Counsel opinion of October 15, 1987, advised that the Solano County Office of Education (SCOE) is considered a "municipal corporation" as defined in Labor Code Section 220 and, therefore, not bound by the 72-hour requirement.

SCOE will pay all wages due employees who separate employment at the first open regular payroll cycle after their separation date.
