Policy 5112.5

Closed Campus

In order to keep students in a supervised, safe, and orderly environment, the Solano County Office of Education (SCOE) establishes a closed campus at all SCOE schools.

Students shall not leave the school grounds at any time during the school day without written permission of their parents/guardians and school authorities. Students who leave school without authorization shall be classified truant and subject to disciplinary action.

Student handbooks shall fully explain all rules and disciplinary procedures involved in the maintenance of the closed campus.

Student Welfare – Special Education

- 1. SCOE shall support the state and federal mandates that all children have a right to a free, appropriate, public education.
- 2. It is the intent of this policy to ensure that students who have been identified, assessed, and placed in programs for individuals with exceptional needs shall have a written individual education program (IEP) that provide for appropriate educational experiences.
- 3. The development and implementation of the IEP will take into consideration the placement of handicapped students with nonhandicapped students.
