Policy 6000

Concepts and Roles

The Solano County Office of Education (SCOE) desires to provide a comprehensive, research-based curriculum that motivates every student to succeed. SCOE's educational program shall provide students with opportunities to attain the skills, knowledge, and abilities they need to be successful in school and develop to their full potential.

Strategies for improving the educational program shall take into consideration the needs of individual students and subpopulations of students.

Inasmuch as parents/guardians are critical partners in their children's education, parents/guardians shall be provided with opportunities to be meaningfully involved both in support of their children's education program at school and with learning at home.

SCOE shall:

- 1. Establish standards of student achievement for core subjects at each grade level that are aligned with its vision for student learning, the specific needs and strengths of the students, the expectations of parents/guardians and the community, and available resources
- 2. Adopt the curriculum and courses of study to be offered
- 3. Adopt textbooks and other instructional materials
- 4. Support the professional staff's implementation of the curriculum by providing consistent policy direction, allocating resources based on educational program priorities, ensuring that collective bargaining agreements do not constrain SCOE's ability to achieve curricular goals, recognizing staff accomplishments, and including reasonable annual goals related to student learning
- 5. Provide a continuing program of professional development to keep instructional staff and administrators updated about current issues and research pertaining to curriculum, instructional strategies, and student assessment
- 6. Review and evaluate the educational program on the basis of state and federal accountability measures, disaggregated student achievement data, and other indicators, and ensure that evaluation results are used to improve programs, curriculum, and/or instructional practices as necessary to enhance student achievement
- 7. Communicate clear information about SCOE's instructional goals, programs, and progress in student achievement to the community and media

The County Superintendent or designee shall:

- 1. Review research related to curriculum issues
- 2. Select and/or develop curricula in accordance with SCOE's curriculum development and review process and state guidelines
- 3. Ensure the articulation of the curriculum between grade levels and with postsecondary education and the workplace
- 4. Determine the general methods of instruction to be used
- 5. Assign instructors and schedule classes for all curricular offerings
- 6. Recommend instructional materials to the Board and direct the purchase of approved materials and equipment
