

ELECTIONS

School District Elections: The County Board of Education, as a whole, shall not become involved in school district elections. As individuals, Trustees may:

- Take a position on a candidate or measure at an open and public hearing.
- Use titles in endorsing a candidate or measure (for identification purposes only).
- Speak in support of a candidate or measure (so long as not using public resources).
- Provide impartial informational material to the public. (Education Code section 7054)
- Donate to a campaign with personal funds.
