North Bay Apprenticeship Coordinators Association (NBACA) Union Apprenticeship Hands-on Construction Career Fair

The Solano County Office of Education (SCOE) co-sponsored the North Bay Apprenticeship Coordinators Association (NBACA) Union Apprenticeship Career Hands-on Construction Career Fair today, April 20, 2018, from 8:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at the Carpenters Training Center located at 800 Chadbourne Road in Fairfield. Attendees had hands-on experience with certified trainers who demonstrated the skills needed to become an apprentice; earning a salary while learning the skills needed to become brick layers, carpenters, cement masons, electricians, plumbers, and more.

There were over 730 registered participants, 600 of which were students from Solano and Napa County schools, who took part in this experience. "This was an extremely beneficial opportunity for our young people to explore a potential career path," says Solano County Superintendent of Schools Lisette-Estrella Henderson.

In addition to co-sponsoring, Solano County Office of Education's Transportation Department supported the Career Fair by transporting over 40 students from Vanden High School and Travis Education Center.

The California Apprenticeship programs are located throughout Northern, Central, and Southern California aimed at providing a networking environment for educators and professionals in the formal apprenticeship training field.
