PRIMARY FUNCTION

Provides for the physical education training/instruction/coordination of individualized education programs for students enrolled in special classes.

DIRECTLY RESPONSIBLE TO

Administrator of Special Education programs

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

A valid California credential authorizing Adapted Physical Education services to the adapted physical education students with disabilities.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

In the areas of physical education:

Participates in IEP.

Assists in identifying and evaluating individuals with disabilities through diagnostic screening and detailed evaluation procedures.

Instructs and trains students with disabilities.

Evaluates daily performances of each student and adjusts future instruction accordingly.

Evaluates total program of each student through the use of tests/observations.

Confers with parents at school, by phone, in writing, and/or in making home visits as needed.

Participates in staffings to determine appropriate instructional program for individuals with disabilities.

Prepares written reports to other professional persons and to parents.

Maintains necessary up-to-date information relating to registers, reports, etc.

MARGINAL DUTIES

Performs other duties within the scope of Adapted Physical Education.
