JOB TITLE: Facilities/Maintenance Coordinator

DESCRIPTION OF BASIC FUNCTION AND RESPONSIBILITY

To perform or coordinate the performance of all maintenance and repairs of agency's facilities and equipment.

JOB REQUIREMENTS AND QUALIFICATIONS

- Possession of a valid California state driver's license.
- Knowledge of modern methods, materials, and equipment and their uses in the performance of maintenance and repair tasks.
- Minimum of three (3) years of experience as a licensed construction contractor or other similar qualifying experience. Experience as a general contractor preferred.
- Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions.
- Ability to perform a variety of semi-skilled and skilled tasks.
- Ability to operate a variety of hand-powered and motor-driven tools and equipment.
- Ability to work effectively and cooperatively with fellow employees, teachers, administrators, students, outside contractors, and the general public.
- Ability to meet the physical requirements for the successful performance of the job.
- Beginning level of skills as measured by a high school diploma or G.E.D. equivalent.
- Experience working in school maintenance and construction preferred.

This work consists of responsible skilled labor at the journeyperson level within a classification series.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

• Receives, prioritizes, and coordinates work requests for maintenance needs.

- Performs semi-skilled and skilled trades, including carpentry, electrical, and plumbing, in the maintenance of agency's facilities.
- Purchases materials needed for maintenance tasks.
- Assists and/or confers with outside contractors in the performance of more complex repairs, construction, or maintenance functions.
- Cleans work areas following completion of maintenance and/or repairs.
- Paints facilities when necessary.
- Sets up equipment for work projects as necessary.
- Moves heavy equipment and/or furniture as necessary.
- Assumes responsibility for the security of assigned area(s).
- Maintains, repairs, orders parts, cleans, inspects, and trains staff on all maintenance and construction equipment.

MARGINAL DUTIES

• Performs related duties as required.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED

Employees in this classification receive general supervision within a broad framework of policies and procedures. Employees in this classification establish daily priorities of workload.

SUPERVISION EXERCISED

Employees in this classification may supervise the work of others in a leadperson capacity.
