JOB TITLE: Maintenance/Construction Tradesperson

DESCRIPTION OF BASIC FUNCTION AND RESPONSIBILITY

Performs all maintenance, preventative maintenance, construction, and repair of agency's facilities and equipment, specializing in HVAC, electrical, plumbing, carpentry, or other building trades.

JOB REQUIREMENTS AND QUALIFICATIONS

- Possession of a valid California state driver's license.
- Knowledge of the principles, practices, methods, techniques, materials, tools, equipment, layouts, and set-ups used in the area of HVAC, electrical, plumbing, carpentry, or other similar qualifying experience.
- Knowledge of the uses and purposes of hand and power tools and equipment, and general maintenance procedures.
- Must be thoroughly familiar with general safety standards and those related to area of specialty. Must maintain knowledge of current code requirements in area of specialties.
- Ability to perform all of the essential duties in the areas of specialization at the journeyperson level with minimal supervision.
- Ability to use and maintain all of the tools, equipment, and vehicles used during routine performance of duties.
- Ability and initiative to independently develop methods and techniques in the interest of effectiveness and efficiency.
- Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions, maintain routine records, and interpret plans and specifications found in the areas of specialization.
- Knowledge of modern methods, materials, and equipment and their uses in the performance of maintenance, construction, and repair tasks.
- Ability to perform a variety of skilled and semi-skilled tasks.

- Ability to operate a variety of hand-powered and motor-driven tools and equipment.
- Ability to work effectively and cooperatively with fellow employees, teachers, administrators, students, outside contractors, and the general public.
- Ability to meet the physical requirements for the successful performance of the job.
- Beginning level of skills as measured by a high school diploma or G.E.D. equivalent
- Possession of Refrigerant and Recovery Certification, or the ability to obtain.
- Possession of Basic Welding Techniques Certificate, or the ability to obtain.

This work consists of responsible skilled labor at the journeyperson level within a classification series.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- Receives and prioritizes work requests for maintenance or repair needs.
- Performs skilled and semi-skilled trades, including carpentry, electrical, HVAC, painting
 and plumbing in the maintenance, preventative maintenance, and construction of agency's
 facilities.
- Purchases materials needed for maintenance and construction tasks.
- Assists and/or confers with outside contractors in the performance of more complex repairs, construction, or maintenance functions.
- Cleans work areas following completion of maintenance, construction, or repairs.
- Sets up equipment for special events as necessary.
- Moves heavy equipment and/or furniture as necessary.
- Assumes responsibility for the security of assigned area(s).

MARGINAL DUTIES

• Performs related duties as required.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED

Employees in this classification receive general supervision within a broad framework of policies and procedures. Employees in this classification establish daily priorities of workload.

SUPERVISION EXERCISED

Employees in this classification may supervise the work of others in a lead person capacity.
