FNL Mentoring provides opportunities for young people to be in ongoing, mutually beneficial, caring relationships which strengthen a young person's resiliency to the challenges they face in life.

## THE MODEL:

- 1. Two lead staff:
  - 1 FNL Coordinator
  - 1 FNL Mentoring Coordinator
- 2. An advisor at each site
- Achieve site buy-in, whether school or community based
- 4. Establish contracted number of sites
- 5. A defined number of mentors & protégés
- 6. Have a recruitment, application, and screening process for Mentors
- 7. Have training for Mentors
- 8. Have selection process for Protégés
- 9. Have an orientation for Protégés
- 10. Have an orientation for parent(s)/guardian(s) of Protégés
- 11. Match Mentors & Protégés
- 12. Have Mentor sessions that will include:
  - A defined number of sessions per week that includes one-one-one time and group time
  - One rap session per week, ability to monitor match
- 13. Have a retention strategy
- 14. Have a clear closure process
- 15. Have an evaluation process
